

RULES GOVERNING PETITIONS - Simplified

1. The top portion of each petition must be filled out completely before you may begin gathering signatures. All of the petitions this PAC distributes will be filled out for you.
2. Only voters in the Talawanda School District may sign our petitions. If they were able to vote on the November 4, 2008 levy, they are probably Talawanda School District voters.
3. All signatures must be in ink, signed by the voter.
4. Only the voter may sign the petition.
5. The voter's address and the date on which he/she signed must be written on the petition.
6. The person circulating the petition does not have to be a registered voter in Ohio, but we prefer it.
7. You cannot sign your own petition, but you may sign the petition of another.
8. After gathering signatures, the person circulating the petition must sign the Circulator Statement on the back of the petition and fill in the number of signatures on the petition and the circulator's complete address.
9. IFA CIRCULATOR KNOWINGLY PERMITS AN UNQUALIFIED PERSON TO SIGN THE PETITION, THE ENTIRE PETITION IS INVALID.
10. Once a petition is filed with the Board of Elections it cannot be changed.
11. Only one person can circulate each petition.
